On 17th May 1990 the World Health Organisation (WHO) removed homosexuality from their list of mental health disorder. In 2019 WHO removed being transgender from the same list.

LGBT people are not mentally ill.

Homophobia is the fear and hatred of gay and lesbian people. It can lead to violent words and action.

Biphobia is the fear and hatred of bisexual people. It can lead to violent words and action.

Transphobia is the fear and hatred of transgender people. It can lead to violent words and action.

According to the All Ireland Traveller Health Study (2010) there are 40,129 Travellers on the island of Ireland. LGBT+ element of any community is estimated to be 10% of the population (The Equality Authority 2002). Just over 4,000 Travellers on the island of Ireland are potentially LGBT+.


