

LGBTI+ GENERAL AWARENESS TRAINING OUTLINE

LGBT Ireland is a national organisation with members in all regions of the country. We run frontline services (LGBT Helpline, peer support groups) and are well placed to understand the needs and issues facing LGBTI+ people, their friends and families.

We deliver tailored LGBTI+ Awareness Training to a range of service providers. The training **methodology** is participatory, reflective, informative and context relevant. Some of the methods include personal exercises, small/large group discussion, scenario problem-solving, presentations.

Delivery methods:

- *In-person:* group size max 25-30 people (will have extra costs of travel + subsistence)
- Online: Max group size is 10-12

Costs

LGBT Ireland is a charity and the training fees support our work. However, fees are negotiable.

Availability: We usually require a 4-6 week lead in and have flexible scheduling options (including daytime/evening/weekends).
